



Urlichich Yuri Matevich

Deputy Head of the Analytical Center under the Government of the Russian Federation.

Born on August 3, 1962 in Moscow.

In 1985 he graduated with honors from Moscow State University of Geodesy and Cartography, in 1996 Moscow State University of Technology and Management.

In 2004 he was awarded the degree of doctor of technical sciences (engineering). Doctorate thesis topic: "System analysis, development and implementation of the methodological apparatus for decision-making in the management of space instrument-making enterprises" Specialty: "System analysis, information management and processing (technical systems)". In 2007 he was granted the professor title. For many years of fruitful scientific activity Yu.M. Urlichich was awarded the title of "Honored Scientist of the Russian Federation" in 2010.

Urlichich Yu.M. is the author of 13 monographs, more than 250 scientific papers, more than 50 patents for inventions and utility models.

He was the first chief designer of the global navigation satellite system GLONASS until 2012.

Urlichich Yu.M. was included in the "first hundred" of the managerial personnel reserve, under the patronage of the President of the Russian Federation.

Urlichich Yu.M. was awarded the Order of Friendship, the Medal of the Order for Services to the Fatherland, II degree, other awards, and is the winner of the Prize of the Russian Federation Government in the field of science and technology.

From 1984 to 2012 he worked in the Russian Space Systems JSC (assignee of FSUE RNIKP). Since 2001 he served as the chief executive officer, in 2009 he was elected chief executive officer and chief designer. In 2006 - 2012 he was the lead designer of the global navigation satellite system GLONASS.

In 2013 - 2014 he was the head of a number of commercial structures in the scientific and technical fields. From 2014 he is the Deputy Head of the Analytical Center under the Government of the Russian Federation.
